- 1. To Vote:** Completely fill in the oval  to the right of your choice like this .  
 For each office vote for up to the number of candidates stated in the sentences: "Vote for not more than 1," or "Vote for up to X;" "X will be elected." If you vote for more than the stated number of candidates, your vote for that office will not be counted.
- 2. To Vote by Write-In:** To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the name of the person in the "write-in" space and completely fill in the oval  to the right of the "write-in" space like this .
